



PNZ SHOOTING PARA SPORT SELECTION CRITERIA

Al Ain 2022 WSPS World Championships, UAE, 3rd - 18th November 2022

This Selection Criteria should be read in conjunction with PNZ's "General Selection Regulation for PNZ Managed Sports": <http://www.paralympics.org.nz/Pathway/High-Performance>

To that the extent that this Selection Criteria is inconsistent or conflicts with PNZ's "General Selection Regulation for PNZ Managed Sports", this Selection Criteria will override and apply.

NOTE: Covid 19 has had an unprecedented impact on the world and continues to evolve both internationally and in New Zealand. As such there could be further changes to the domestic and international calendar, which could result in changes to this Selection Criteria

1. **Eligibility Criteria:** To be eligible to represent the New Zealand Shooting Para Sport team at the 2022 WSPS World Championships an athlete must, in addition to meeting the "Eligibility for Selection" requirements set out at clause 6 of the "General Selection Regulation for PNZ Managed Sports":

- 1.1 Satisfy all of World Shooting Para Sport (**WSPS**) eligibility, nationality, and participation rules;

- 1.2 Be a registered member of Target Shooting New Zealand;

- 1.3 Have:

- (a) competed at the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games in a Shooting Para Sport event; or

- (b) achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (**MQS**) at either:

- (i) a 2022 NZ Grand Prix, Tokoroa, New Zealand 14-20 July 2022;

- (ii) a Changwon 2022 World Cup 15-24 August 2022 competitions; or

- (iii) a WSPS recognised competition: <https://www.paralympic.org/shooting/events-2022>

For MQS scores refer Appendix 1 - for one event between 1 January 2022 and 1 November 2022.

Note: A selected Para athlete may compete in multiple events if they have achieved the MQS score in at least one event.

- 1.4 Hold a current WSPS Licence for the 2022 Season.

- 1.5 Be internationally classified with a "Review" (R) or "Confirmed" (C) sport class status.

2. **Selection Panel**

- 2.1 **Composition:** The Board of PNZ has agreed to the following Selection Panel being appointed for the purpose of making selection decisions pursuant to the General Selection Regulation of PNZ Managed Sports:

- 2.1.1 The Panel of three (3) individuals will consist of:
- New Zealand Shooting Federation - President or nominee.
 - Target Shooting New Zealand - President or nominee.
- 2.1.2 Together with, one (1) individual appointed by the President of New Zealand Shooting Federation from the following:
- New Zealand Clay Target Ass – President or nominee
 - Pistol New Zealand – President or nominee
 - National Rifle Association of New Zealand – President or nominee
 - Sport Development Manager – or nominee

3. Timeline

- 15 July 2022: Para athletes return signed selection application forms
- 14 - 20 July 2022: NZ Grand Prix
- 15 - 24 August 2022: Changwon World Cup, South Korea
- 1 September 2022: Selectors meeting
- 12 September 2022: Selection decision made / announced (with all successful / unsuccessful Para athletes notified)
