



PNZ Shooting Para Sport Selection Criteria

Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships, PERU, 19th - 29th September 2023

Please Note: These selection criteria should be read in conjunction with the PNZ General Selection Regulation for PNZ Managed Sports (see [PNZ webpage](#)).

1.0 Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to represent the New Zealand Shooting Para Sport team at the 2023 WSPS World Championships an athlete must -

- 1.1 Comply with all PNZ policies
- 1.2 Satisfy all WSPS, eligibility, nationality, and participation rules
- 1.3 Be a registered member of (Target Shooting NZ) TSNZ and or (Pistol NZ) PNZ
- 1.4 Athletes must have achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) at a WSPS recognised competition for one event between 01 January 2022 and 15 September 2023. An athlete may compete in multiple events if they have achieved the MQS score in each event. (MQS scores refer to [Appendix 1](#))
- 1.5 Hold a current WSPS Licence for the 2023 Season.
- 1.6 Be internationally classified with a "Review" (R) or "Confirmed" (C) sport class status on or before December 2023.

2.0 Selection Panel

2.1 NZSF Selection Panel

NZSF Selection Panel of 3 people will be appointed by the NZSF Executive; and consist of the

- New Zealand Shooting Federation - President or nominee
- Target Shooting New Zealand - President or nominee
- New Zealand Clay Target Ass – President or nominee
- Pistol New Zealand – President or nominee
- National Rifle Association of New Zealand – President or nominee
- Sport Development Manager – or nominee

The NZSF Selection Panel will ratify athlete selections for NZ representatives.

Conflict of interest

If the NZSF Executive believes any NZSF selector has, or may have a potential or actual conflict, then that NZSF selector may not participate in any discussions or voting decisions which may be affected by the conflict of interest; and that NZSF Selector will be replaced by his or her nominee appointed by the relevant discipline

3.0 Extenuating Circumstances

3.1 These criteria apply, in considering the performance of the athlete, the selection panel may, at their discretion and on a case-by-case basis, consider extenuating circumstances as part of the nomination process. Such circumstances may include but are not limited to.

- Equipment Failure
- Injury or Illness of the Athlete
- Travel Delays
- Bereavement

Such other circumstances as the selection panel may reasonably consider constitute extenuating circumstances.

Athletes who are unable to compete in and/or attend the event, trial, training, or other required attendances must advise the PNZ Shooting Para Sport Lead and or PNZ Games Campaign and Sports Manager in writing of this fact and the reason before the commencement of any of the listed matches. Or if it occurs within twelve (12) hours before the match, by phone as soon as possible after it arises, and follow up in writing.

In case of injury or illness, the athlete may be required to undergo a medical assessment by a doctor or doctors nominated by Paralympics NZ and the affiliate before they can give weight to any extenuating circumstance.

 - PNZ Athlete Application Form for selection to the NZ Team to attend the Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships
 - 2023 PNZ General Selection Regulations
 - PNZ Shooting Para Sport 2023 World Championships Selection Criteria (with MQS)
- **1st June 2023** Athletes return signed selection application forms
- **12 July 2023** Selectors to meet
- **20 July 2023** Selections Announced
