

### **J TPC: TERM PROCESSING CENTRE**

The Team Processing Centre (TPC) is the single point of entry on arrival at the Village.

# 03 RESIDENTIAL AREAS

The residential zone offers a full range of services for Village residents. Access to this area is restricted to residents and non-residents with an ID and an Olympic (OIAC) and Paralympic (PIAC) accrediation with the indication «R». Guests with a Guest Pass and accompagnied with someone carrying an accreditation with the «R» indication can access the residential zone.

### **LAUNDRY**

The Village has a laundry desk on the ground floor of some residences.

Separate dark and light clothes and check that each laundry bag is no more than two-thirds full.

**Deposited laundry is** registered with a QR code for each bag, linked to your accreditation. Make sure to collect your confirmation receipt



Laundry will be washed and dried in the bags but will not be folded or ironed.

Collect your laundry from the same laundry desk with your accreditation. Laundry bags must be dropped off and collected by the same person carrying their personal accreditation.









### **DROP-OFF BEFORE 10:00**

Laundry can be collected before 18:00 the same day.

### **DROP-OFF AFTER 10:00**

Laundry can be collected 24 hours after the drop-off time.

### **GENERAL RULES**

- → Several laundry bags can be dropped off on the same day
- → If the bag is too full, the laundry receptionist may refuse to take the bag.
- → The bag's zip must be closed so that the bag does not open during the washing cycle.
- → Residents must collect their bag of clean laundry from the laundry desk it was dropped off at.
- → All bags must be collected at the latest 48 hours after drop-off.

Separate dark and light clothes and check that each laundry bag is no more than two-thirds full.

Drop off the bag at **laundry B5.** Make sure you are carrying your accreditation. You will receive a **drop-off** confirmation receipt.

Collect the laundry within 12 hours from laundry B5. Make sure to bring your drop-off confirmation receipt. Laundry will not be

folded or ironed.

Laundry bags must be collected from laundry B5 on your arrival at the Village during opening hours. Laundry may be dropped off and collected by two different people.



Paris 2024 provides containers on the ground floor of residential buildings for waste sorting and disposal.




### **GENERAL STORE**

The post office allows you to send letters and packages to France and abroad. The post office also offers entertainment.




### **RECEPTION LOUNGE**

A giant screen will be installed on the Village Plaza and will show the Games competitions.





### **↓ TRAINING VENUES**

The Village has eight training venues within its security perimeter. A breaking and wrestling training venue will be located outside of the Village.

**Sports:** weightlifting, basketball, wheelchair basketball, 3x3 basketball, breaking, fencing, wheelchair fencing, goalball, handball, wrestling, modern pentathlon, Para powerlifting, Para taekwondo, sitting volleyball.

The Village training venues are solely accessible to accredited persons with the necessary sports codes and to "P" accredited personnel for the sport in question (only on the day of training and in accordance with the training schedule).

### FITNESS CENTER

With more than 350 sport equipments and saunas, the Fitness Centre is a key service for athletes wanting to perfect their physical preparation in a private and high-performance space.

A sauna per gender is dedicated for athletes concerned by the weigh-in.

Space devoted to mental health and safety in sport.

Also dedicated to physical relaxation where athletes can rest and recover, but also concentrate, prepare and stimulate their minds for the next training session or competition. # **BUILDING RULES**



### **NO COOKING**

Cooking is not permitted in the residential apartments or outside spaces of the Village.



### **SMOKING**

Smoking is authorised only in the designated areas.

Smoking is not permitted outside of these smoking spaces.



### **ALCOHOL**

Alcoholic drinks are not available for sale in the Village, but alcohol may be consumed within the Village.



### **QUIET HOURS**

Between 22:00 and 07:00, moderate noise is tolerated within the Village and accommodation and communal areas must be quiet.



### **GUIDE DOGS**

A dedicated space will be provided for guide dogs for residents concerned.



### **BIKES AND RESPECT FOR PROPERTY**

Bikes are available for residents only. Bikes must not leave the Village security perimeter. Users must leave bikes in the designated areas. Bikes must not be left on pavements or anywhere that may disrupt public circulation or damage green spaces.



Residents must observe the basic rules of community living. Incivility and inappropriate behaviour is subject to penalty.
